

**CLARIFICATIONS ON THE CHANGES IN ACADEMIC RULES AND REGULATIONS**

**(Approved in the 314 Senate, 23 September 2015)**

Subsequent to the document circulated on the changes in Academic Rules (approved in 314 Senate), questions regarding the date from which the changes would be effective and queries related to the Dual Degree Internship are clarified below:

However for the present third year batch of Dual Degree students, please read the additional clarifications in the adjacent column.</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Henceforth all Dual Degree Students will do their compulsory internship at the end of 4<sup>th</sup> year.</li> <li>❖ As the process of obtaining internship for the ongoing third year Dual degree students has already begun, the following relaxation is provided only for the current third year Dual Degree Students: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Current third year Students of the Dual Degree program who have already obtained an internship either through CDC or through their personal efforts will be allowed to proceed on internship at the end of third year, i.e., May-July 15.</li> <li>○ Students who have obtained internship through their personal effort must produce documentary evidence before 28 Feb 2016.</li> <li>○ The Internship evaluation will be in the 9<sup>th</sup> semester along with the other Dual Degree Students.</li> <li>○ All other Dual Degree students of the current third year who have not obtained an internship by 28 Feb 2016 will do their internship at the end of their fourth year.</li> </ul> </li> <li>❖ Henceforth the project registration of the fourth year Dual Degree students is done away with.</li> <li>❖ They will register for the project along with the other curricular and start attending classes along with the other students in July as per the date specified in the Academic Calendar.</li> <li>❖ Assistantship will be paid to eligible Dual Degree students from the day of commencement of classes.</li> <li>❖ Students who are switching over from B.Tech.(Hons.) to the Dual Degree Program will have their</li> </ul>

**Registration Rules in item 3 are applicable for Students who are in the Academically Weak Category.**

**Students (not in Academically Weak Category ) with one Backlog – Can Register for the prescribed semester loading with the Backlog subject.**

**Students with two Backlogs (not in Academically Weak Category ) —Can Register for a Maximum of 28 credits. This may include a concurrent project Registration as well for fourth year Dual Degree Students.**

**Students with two Backlogs (not in Academically Weak Category ) and Final Year –Can Register for two Backlogs over and above the prescribed credit limit. This may include a concurrent project Registration.**

**Students with more than two Backlogs fall in the Academically Weak Category and are governed by the rules in item 3.**
